## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE 3, SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS, SECTION 3.06, PARKING AND STORAGE OF RECREATION VEHICLES, COMMERCIAL VEHICLES, AND AUTOMOBILES IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS, OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF ROMULUS. THE CITY OF ROMULUS ORDAINS:

Section 1. Article 3, Single Family Residential Districts, Section 3.06, Parking and Storage of Recreation Vehicles, Commercial Vehicles, and Automobiles in Residential Districts is amended to read as follows:

Section. 3.06 – Parking and Storage of Recreation Vehicles, Commercial Vehicles, and Automobiles in Residential Districts.

Said ordinance shall thereupon and thereby be suspended from operation and the Council shall immediately reconsider such ordinance.
